Principal's Message:

Greetings EMS Families:

The Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBA) is almost upon us and below you will find details of our testing schedule this year.

- All students will take the English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics assessments with their content-specific teachers.
- The ELA and Math SBA are broken into two components: (1) the Computer Adaptive Test (CAT) and (2) the Performance Task (PT).
- 8th grade students will also take the Washington Comprehensive Assessment of Science (WCAS).
- All students will follow a regular bell schedule each day.
- If a student does not finish the assessment on Day 1, then they simply pause the test and continue on Day 2, etc. We have built-in more than the state recommended time to allow for all students to finish within the schedule provided.
- If a student misses a day of testing, make-up testing days have been embedded into the testing window, with the last week of May only dedicated to make-ups.
- Testing will take place over 4 weeks.

We hope that keeping a regular daily schedule throughout testing and allowing students to test with their content-specific teachers will reduce test anxiety and eliminate the impact to other classes throughout each day.
